

# **Holiday Visits & Guidelines 2020**

## **Thanksgiving**

7 hour Off-Hill Passes may be scheduled on November 26, 27, 28, or 29, for students who are eligible.

Off-Hill Passes on Thanksgiving Day, November 26, will only be for those whose family is within driving distance to allow for a home visit within the allowed time:

Approximately a one hour drive.

No items can be brought back from this 7 hour pass.

Call your loved one's minister to schedule the pass at least 2 weeks in advance.

### **The following must be observed to assure students' success:**

- **Teen Challenge is a Drug, Alcohol, and Tobacco Free Environment. Please ok help us keep it that way.**
- **Visitation is restricted to immediate family members only.**
- **No Cell phones are allowed to be used by students while on or off campus.**
- **Masks should be worn when distances of 6 feet or more cannot be kept.**
- **If any family member has fever, related symptoms, or has had recent contact with someone positive for COVID-19, please reschedule your visit.**
- **Students will be subject to drug and tobacco testing upon return.**

## **On-Campus**

Families may schedule a 3 hour on-site visit December 24, 25, 26, or 27. Please check with the student's minister for available times. \*No gifts may be brought to loved ones on this visit.

## **7 Hour Off-Hill Pass**

Students who are eligible may have a scheduled 7 Hour Off-Hill Pass on December 26 or 27. Please contact your loved ones minister to schedule at least 2 weeks in advance.

No items can be brought back from this 7 hour pass.

## **7 Day Pass Home**

We are encouraging those eligible for a 7 day pass in November through January to take it for Christmas, December 22-29. Only items on the *What To Bring List* may be brought back from this 7 day pass.
